Dear Purnaa Customers,

Kathmandu experienced devastating floods on Aug 27th and 28th, impacting many lives across the city. We are relieved to share that all of our Purnaa employees are safe, though several have suffered significant loss, including damage to their homes and personal belongings..

At Purnaa, our team is rallying together to support each other and the broader community during this challenging time. We deeply appreciate the concern and well-wishes we've received from our valued partners and customers as we navigate the recovery process.

Here are some key updates:

- 12 of our employees had their homes flooded, and we will be supporting them through emergency assistance funds, clothing drives, and house restoration assistance.
- Our factory was undamaged, but our main access road experienced a landslide, and access to the factory will be obstructed for a few days.
- We closed the factory from August 28 to October 1, which will cause slight production delays.

While our top priority remains the safety and well-being of our employees, we are committed to working closely with you to ensure we catch up to our targeted production timelines as quickly as possible. Your understanding and continued support mean a great deal to us during this time.
